This provides a great opportunity for the athlete and the coach to see what the barrel is doing before the shot is fired. It is an awesome training tool. All shooting on them has to be done in dry fire mode so ensure your air rifles can dry fire. .22 rifles just need a piece of brass in the chamber.

The Canada Winter Games is the largest national multi-sport event with more than 5000 volunteers, 2,700 athletes, 20 sports, 18 days and a whole lot of fun! Alberta Rifle Team Belle Medicraft, Shaylene Lunam, Michael Erickson, Brandon Hardy and Coach Susan Eymann started their adventure four years ago — shortly after the Team Alberta returned from the 2011 Halifax Games — and an adventure they will not forget anytime soon.

Besides flying on a chartered West Jet flight, experiencing a very welcoming Games Village, receiving a full set of team Alberta gear, making friends from across the country, our young athletes experienced a very high level of competition. For some this will be the pinnacle in their competitive target shooting career, for others it is just the start.

The Target Shooting events consists of two events, the team event where two female (and two male) teammates shoot one relay each, combined scores make their team score, and the individual event which consists of one relay and the top eight shoot the finals. Congratulations to Belle and Brandon for making top eight.

Belle Medicraft, Michael Erickson and Brandon Hardy each shot a Junior National Cut Score which is step one to being on the National Junior Team (step two is attending the 2015 National Championship in Ontario).

Form for borrowing SCATT machine systems with computers.

This agreement is between ASRA and _____ (hereafter called CLUB) a shooting club in the Province of Alberta.

By this agreement ASRA (as trustee) is lending at nominal cost (\$1/day as of November 2013), a SCATT laser training system to the CLUB for use in training and demonstrations in their area. The CLUB will pay for the transportation to obtain the unit and it's return to 2033-74 Street NW Edmonton, AB T6K 2L3 or to the next location wanting to use it.

The CLUB agrees to post a \$2000 cheque as guarantee for the safe return of the system. This cheque will be returned to the CLUB or destroyed upon the return of the system in full working order. The CLUB will be responsible for any repairs needed while the machine is in their possession.

It is understood if the system is not returned on request the \$2000 cheque will be cashed to enable a new system to be purchased in replacement. If the system is returned, but not fully functional, any repairs will be deducted from the \$2000 deposit.

The system will be lent to clubs for a 3 week period that may be formally renewed as deemed fit based on the demand from other locations.

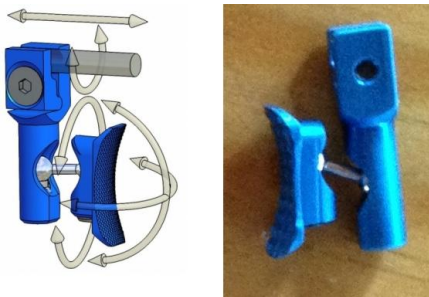

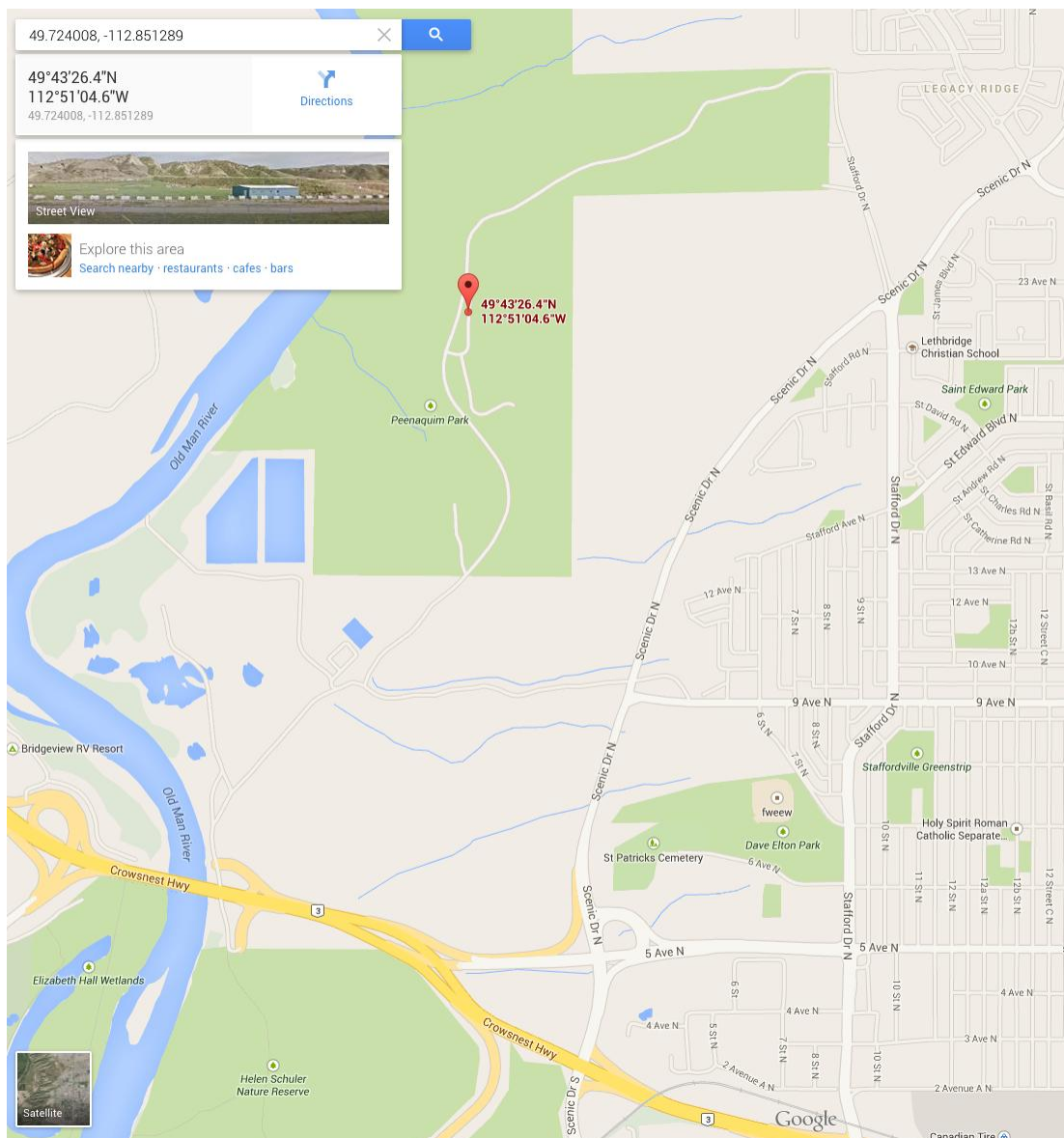
