This was a cold miserable day that made the provincials look like a picnic. The intention was to shoot two matches of the 100yd and one person shot the one range and joined the others who had decided not to shoot it at all.

### **Canadian Nationals**

Alberta sent 4 athletes to the Canadian national rifle matches and they all did a great job in representing our province. **Daniela Sirbu** placed 4<sup>th</sup> in the Ladies air rifle and achieved a cut score to qualify for the Ladies air rifle national training team.

**Jeff Hunter, Sheldon Dobish and Wynn Payne** each shot qualifying scores for the men's .22 prone national training team. Wynn managed a fifth place finish after a poor first match. He also backed into the veteran's award because a veteran who finished ahead of him didn't register as such.

The weather was overcast most of the time with rain happening in the evenings with spots during the day but luckily not during the ,22 match rifle events. All the target boxes worked well for the ISSF shooting but failed for one relay in the heavy rain for the sporting rifle events. (The targets were replaced and no further problems.) The wind was moderate but constantly changing in strength and direction, making the competition scores somewhat lower than normal.

The clubhouse at the .22 range still serves great burgers and pies so we were able to drown our sorrows in food while commiserating about the low scores.

**Chris Congram** of BC was the men's .22 prone match winner. Not one person shot the cut score in all three matches giving some indication the difficulty the wind created.

Greg Sych was the men's air rifle and 3p winner showing why he is competitive with international scores.

**Shannon Westlake** of Ontario won many of the Ladies .22 events including the high overall awards.

Cassandra Wilson-Anderson of Saskatchewan won the Ladies air rifle event.

There were no bids submitted to host next year's nationals but Beachburg has indicated they would be a fallback position if no other group comes forward. There was some rumor about Grandby Quebec hosting the event and having enough electronic targets to hold a paperless nationals. At this point that rumor is not confirmed. The suggested date was the first week in Aug as was this year.

The rifle section meeting was run by **Azmir Arifovic**. Azmir is the President of the Shooting Federation of Canada and has volunteered to serve as chair of the rifle section. A thanks to **Steve Spinney** for taking over the organization of the event replacing Janet Trace who was in London officiating at the Olympics.

**Pauline Pilkington** indicated this is her last nationals. She has served in many capacities but primarily as the person in charge of officials and all that officials are responsible for. le scoring, range officers etc. Pauline is on the technical committee for the ISSF and has often served as jury member for international matches such as Olympics, Commonwealth Games and World Cups.
